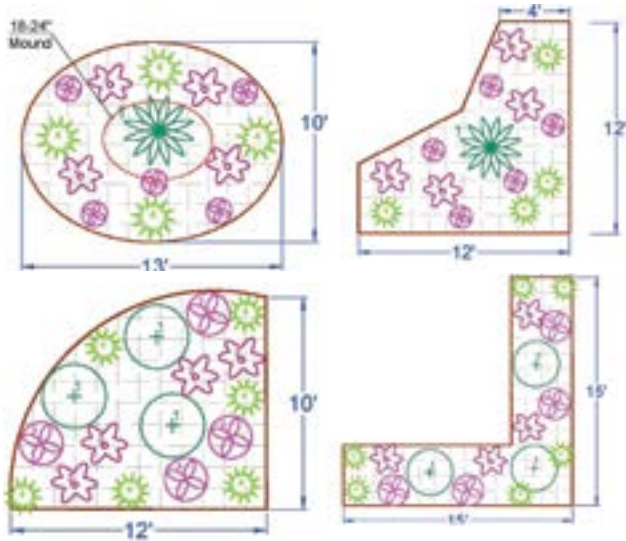

Program Information

The Garden by Number rebate pilot program is a do-it-yourself rebate program that provides themed prepackaged ready-made garden boxes. The box includes a plant-by-number map to layout the design, an instruction sheet, information on watering, a plant care guide, and 10 to 15 healthy starter plants.

Before Applying

- Read Terms and Conditions to confirm you are eligible for a rebate.
- Select your garden box style and pick-up location. Options are available at www.zone7water.com/conservation-rebates/rebate-programs.
- Decide where you want to install your Garden by Number plants. Take a photo of the area where you plan to install your garden for your rebate application.
- Print a copy of your current water bill to include in your rebate application.

Application Process

- Fill out your application at www.zone7water.com/conservation-rebates/rebate-programs.
- When you receive an approval code to purchase your box, take your approval code to the nursery you have selected and pay a 50% deposit. The remaining balance is due when you pick up your box. If you decide later not to participate in the program, the deposit will be refunded as a store credit.
- You will be notified when your box is ready to be picked up. Estimated date is April 2020.

- Prep your yard and plant your Garden by Number box as per the Garden by Number Instructions sheet.
- Alden Lane and Western Garden nurseries are offering a 20% discount on mulch, compost, and cardboard.

Terms & Conditions

Eligibility

- Applicant must live in a single-family home and be a customer of Dublin San Ramon Services District (DSRSD), the City of Livermore, or the City of Pleasanton. Program is not available to California Water Service Company - Livermore customers.
- Applicant's water account must be in good standing and have an active meter.
- The account must have a history of at least one year of water use.
- Applicants must have minimum of 200 square feet of lawn in their front yard and replace 100 square feet of front lawn with Garden by Number plants to receive the rebate.
- Customer must eliminate overhead sprinklers in the garden box planting area and convert sprinkler heads to drip irrigation.

Rebate Details

- The program is subject to change or end without notice. The rebate amount may not exceed the purchase price.
- Only one rebate per household every two years. Two garden boxes can be purchased per single-family property. Maximum rebate is \$100 for two garden boxes and \$50 for one garden box.
- The rebate is issued as a credit to your water bill account. If you pay your water bill through a homeowners' association or landlord, the water customer on the billing account will receive the rebate.
- Participants must follow the Garden by Number instructions and take pictures after each step in order to receive the rebate.
