

To StreamWISE Stakeholders -

We are in the process of defining, prioritizing and sequencing the projects that will constitute our 5-, 10- and 30-year Capital Improvement Programs in what we are now calling the StreamWISE Program (formerly known as the Stream Management Master Plan, or SMMP).

The first series of five Stakeholder meetings was held in May. At these meetings, Stakeholders shared their top project priorities and criteria. A summary is attached for your information.

Based on Stakeholder input and other criteria, we are in the process of screening the 45 project concepts identified in the SMMP, and selecting which project concepts to advance in the implementation planning process.

Please join me in the second series of Stakeholder meetings to be held on Tuesday, June 26, Wednesday, June 27 and Thursday, June 28. You are welcome to attend any of the meetings listed below depending on your interests. Each meeting is intended to focus on an aspect of particular interest to a specific group of Stakeholders.

At each of these meetings, we will share the draft list of project concepts narrowed from the original list of 45 identified in the SMMP, and the basis for this selection. The purpose of the meetings will be to hear Stakeholder input about the list. If we are able to prepare the list in time to provide you with an advance copy, we will do so.

Also at these meetings, we will be discussing the StreamWISE team's next steps with respect to both additional technical work and moving forward to identify potential project-specific partnering opportunities. Please be prepared to discuss your thoughts about your organization's partnering interests.
