

# **2024-01 RFQ for Engineering Design Services for Repairs of Storm Damages to Flood Protection Facilities -Questions from Proposers**

**1. Is Zone 7 asking for consultants to put together a team for this RFQ?**

No, we will make that determination at the time of the RFP. This is just an RFQ for engineering design services.

**2. Will there be separate RFP(s) for CM services for these repairs?**

**3. Will serving in the role as a prime consultant in the design phase prohibit that firm from proposing on and providing CM services during construction?**

**4. Will serving in the role as a subconsultant in the design phase prohibit that firm from proposing on and providing CM services during construction?**

**5. Are they in earthen or concrete open channels?**

Earthen.

**6. Are there hydraulic structures involved?**

**7. Is there anticipated road repairs associated with the damaged sites?**

A few Aggregate Base (AB) operational roads adjacent to the damaged bank areas may need to be repaired.

**8. Is stream restoration to stabilize the channel and prevent future erosion part of the anticipated scope of repairs?**

We anticipate implementing mitigation measures to better protect the repairs from future damage.

**9. Is the RFQ asking for a firm and subconsultants to perform all the scope of services or do we submit to the areas we are most qualified for?**

The intent of the RFQ is to qualify respondents that are fully capable of providing engineering design services to address the need of preparing plans/specifications/cost estimates for future bank repair projects. The preliminary scope of work is for respondents to gain an understanding of what a future bank repair project Request for Proposal may entail.
