FY 2024-25 Highlights

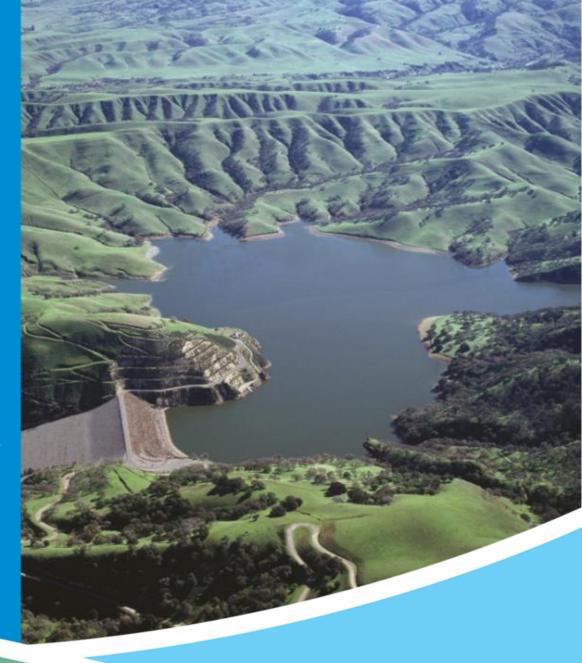
- Treated water sales are \$1.7M higher than budget. The Agency continues to provide additional water to Pleasanton due to PFAS.
- Rapid construction in Livermore has led to water connection fees exceeding budget by ~\$10.8M.
- Water Reliability Reserve balance is \$9.8M based on Unaudited Actuals.
- Flood Protection storm repair projects underspent due to permitting delays.

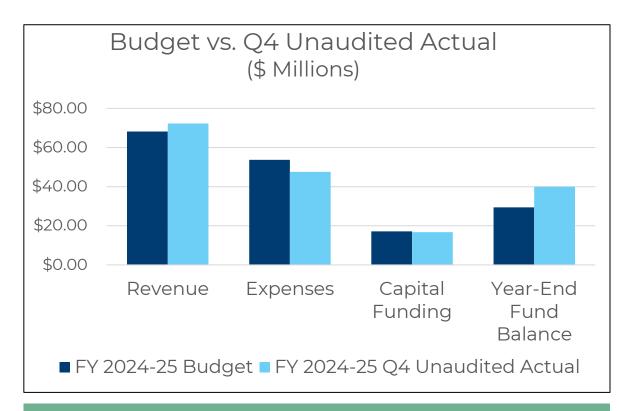

Year-end Reserves Funded at Target Levels

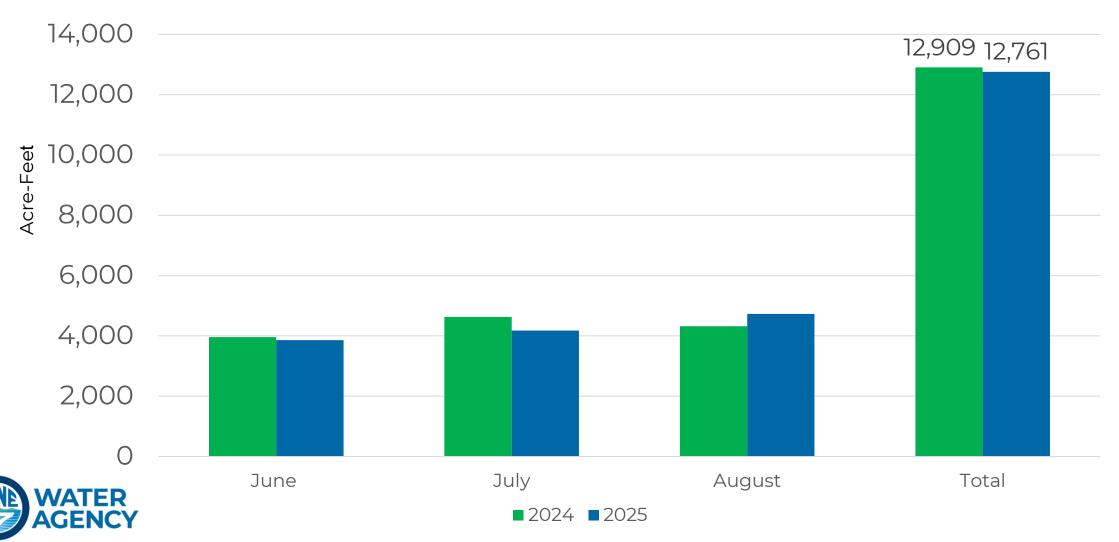
Major Variances

- Total Revenue > Budget
 - Water Sales (+\$1.7M)
 - Los Vaqueros Project Refund (+1.3M)
- Water costs < Budget
 - DCP Charges (-~\$2.1M)
 - Water Transfers/Banking Programs/Conveyance (-~\$1.6M)

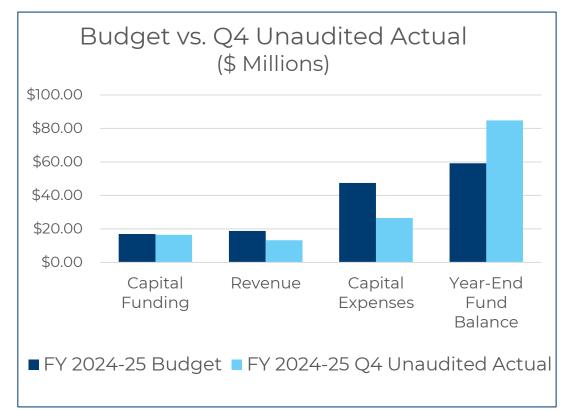
Water Supply Reliability Reserve: ~\$9.8M

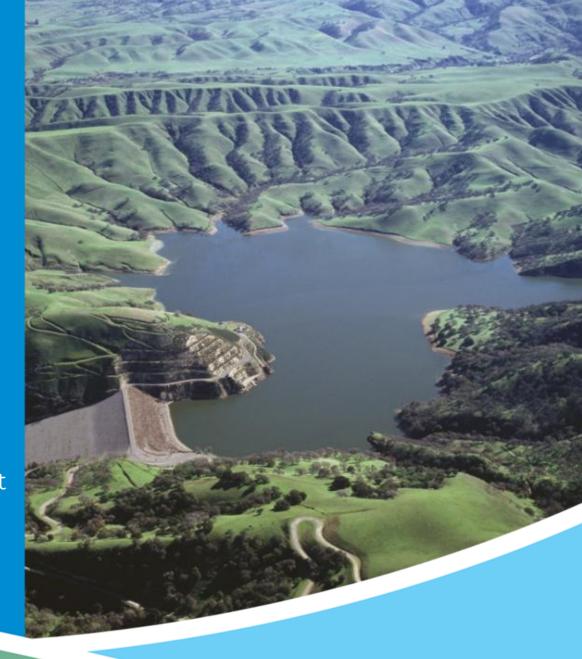

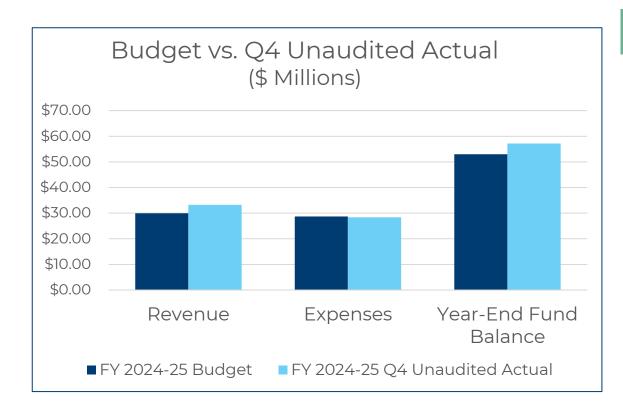

Year-End Reserves Compliant with Reserve Policy

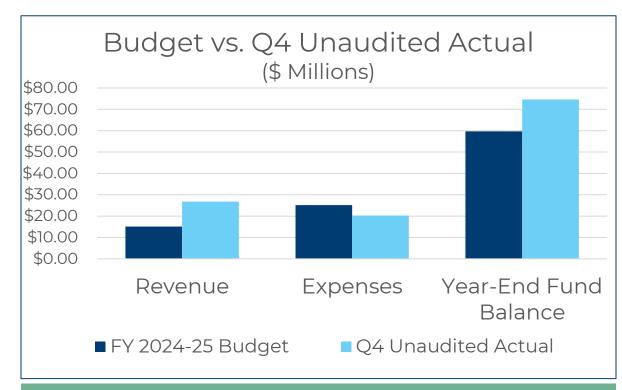


Major Variances

- Total Revenue > Budget
 - Increases in assessed value
 - Supplemental, Unsecured, and Prior Year Taxes
 - Unanticipated DWR refunds
- Expenses = on par with budget

Major Variances

- Total Revenue > Budget
 - Connection Fees: +\$10.8M
 - New developments in the Isabel Neighborhood Plan Area
 - Arroyo Vista

 - Multi-year projects





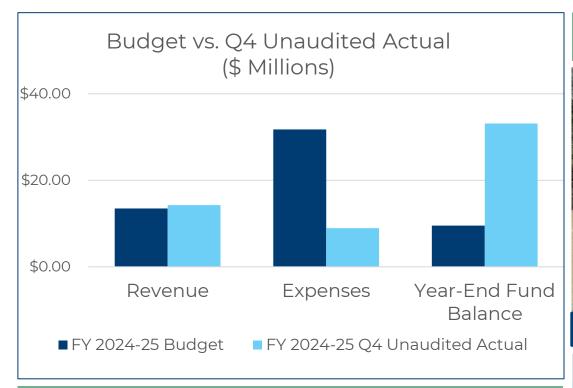

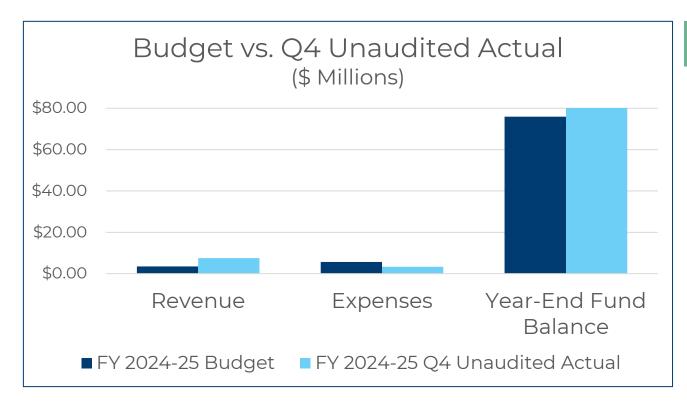
