

2023 Storm Damages-January & March Storm Events

- 177 sites with bank damages from January and March storm events
- Damages include bank failures and erosion
- In a normal year, Zone 7 experiences only about eight to ten bank slides.

Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

- To design and be prepared to address repairs of storm damages in a timely manner, staff is seeking to pre-qualify and approve engineering design services to assist with:
 - 1) Preparation of detailed engineering plans, specifications, and cost estimates
 - 2) Assist in environmental permitting
- A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was posted on August 24. Submission period ended October 18.
- A similar process was done for the 2017's storm damages



List of Qualified Firms

- Zone 7 received seven (7) statement of qualifications (SOQs), and a Zone 7 review panel determined that only six (6) firms were qualified to provide the necessary design services.
- The six (6) firms proposed to be placed on a list of approved qualified firms, to solicit project specific proposals over the next five-year period.
- Eligibility on the list does not guarantee work.

Cost/Funding

- Costs related to the repair of storm damages may be partially reimbursable through Federal and State agencies assistance programs that Zone 7 has applied for.
- Total cost about \$41,000,000.
- Design and environmental permitting to be \$6,100,000.
- Need to appropriate an additional \$1,000,000 in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Budget to fund an initial contract for design and environmental permitting services.
- Remaining \$5,100,000 needed for design and environmental permitting services will be requested in subsequent FY Budget requests from Fund 200 – Flood Protection Operations.



Recommended Action

Adopt the resolution

- 1. Approve the **qualified firms list** to be used during the **five-year period** ending November 30, 2028, to provide design and environmental permitting services to repair damages to flood protection facilities.
- 2. Authorize the **General Manager to negotiate**, **execute**, **and amend** as necessary, one or more contracts with any of the firms on the approved list to provide design and environmental permitting services to repair damages to flood protection facilities, for a total of all contracts not-to-exceed amount of **\$6,100,000**.
- 3. The Board appropriate an additional \$1,000,000 in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 Budget to fund the initial contract for design and environmental permitting services to repair damage to flood protection facilities.
